38TH Mill Valley Film Festival, October 8 – 18, 2015 Celebrating the Best in Independent and World Cinema

A DIRECTOR PREPARES DOCUMENTARY SERIES ABOUT MAKING OF ICONIC TELEVISION AND INDIE FILM TO PREMIERE AT THE 38TH MILL VALLEY FILM FESTIVAL

SAN RAFAEL, Calif. (October 2, 2015) – The California Film Institute announced today, veteran film and television director **Bobby Roth** will premiere his new documentary series, *A Director Prepares*, at the 38th Mill Valley Film Festival. The workshop will offer aspiring filmmakers and anyone interested in how film and television are made an incredible opportunity to learn first hand from one of the industry's most established directors of episodic television.

Bobby, whose most recent television directing credits include *Scorpion, Marvel's Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D.*, and *Grey's Anatomy*, will screen all ten episodes of the groundbreaking series in conjunction with teaching a Master Class on Saturday and Sunday, October 10th and 11th, from 10:00AM–1:00PM, at the historic Sweetwater Music Hall in Mill Valley.

Bobby Roth has directed more than eighty episodes of television, thirteen feature films, and twenty-five television movies. He was a founding member of the Independent Feature Project and the first Co-Chairman of the DGA's Independent Feature Committee. His films have been exhibited at over 100 international film festivals, including Sundance, where he has also served as a jury member, and Berlin, where his film *Heartbreakers* was nominated for a Golden Bear. He holds a BA in Cinema from USC and an MFA in Motion Picture Production from UCLA, and he has been teaching film seminars worldwide for more than ten years.
