# MILL VALLEY FILM FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES 2019 FESTIVAL DATES AND CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

SAN RAFAEL, CA (February 18, 2019) – Mark Fishkin, Founder and Executive Director of the California Film Institute (CFI), announced today **the 42nd Mill Valley Film Festival** (MVFF42) will be held **Thursday, October 3 – Sunday, October 13, 2019**.

Zoë Elton, MVFF Director of Programming, also announced the Mill Valley Film Festival is **now accepting submissions** for feature length (50+ minutes) and short films in the following categories: Narrative, Documentary, Animation, Children and Family, Experimental and Youth Produced. Festival sections include World Cinema, US Cinema, Valley of the Docs, Music, the filmHOOD children and Family program, and the popular "5@5" shorts program. Films invited to the Festival may also be included in our ongoing initiatives, Mind the Gap, Active Cinema and ¡Viva el Cine!.

Mill Valley Film Festival offers a high profile, prestigious, non-competitive environment perfect for celebrating the best in independent and world cinema alongside high profile award season contenders. MVFF has a knack for spotting emerging talent as well as drawing legendary artists. Known as the "filmmaker's festival", MVFF welcomes more than 200 filmmakers and guests from around the world.

## MVFF's regular submission period begins Monday, February 18, 2019.

- Early Deadline: Friday, May 17, 2019
- Final Deadline: Friday, June 14, 2019
- Extended Deadline: Friday, June 28, 2019
